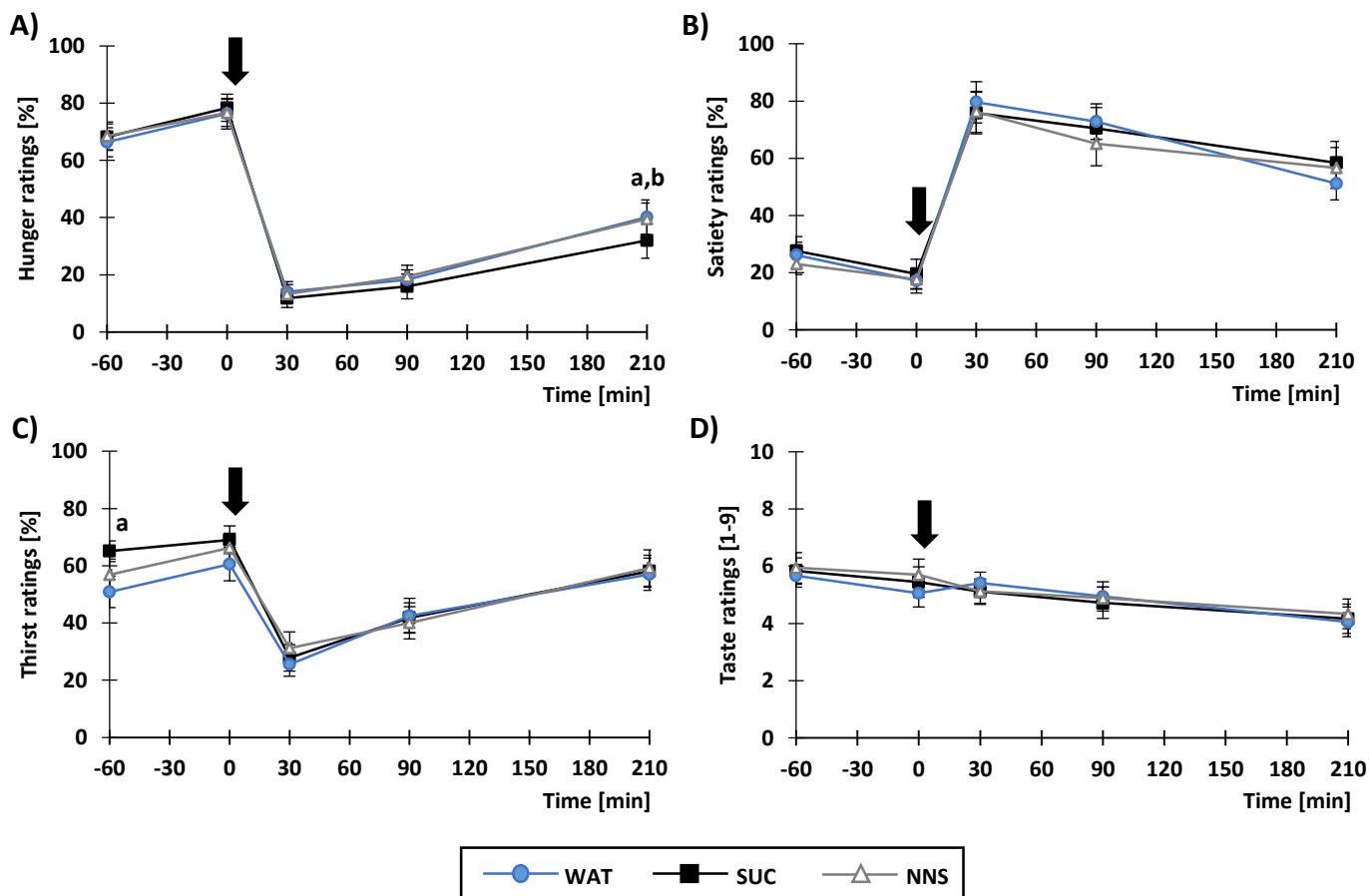


Figure S1. Behavioral ratings for hunger (A), satiety (B), thirst (C) and taste cravings (D) in response to drink and concomitant standardized meal ingestion at $T = 0$ minute, indicated by a black arrow. A taste rating of 1 indicates the maximum preference for a salty item whereas 9 indicates the maximum preference for a sweet item. Data are presented as mean \pm SEM. ^{a, b}: $p < 0.05$ for post-hoc paired t-tests (two-tailed), respectively between SUC-WAT and SUC-NNS. WAT, SUC, NNS: Water-, Sucrose-, NNS-beverage conditions.
