Institutional Open Access Program

Our Institutional Open Access Program

Our Institutional Open Access Program (IOAP) is designed to help institutions manage the transition to the Open Access publishing model. Researchers affiliated with participating universities benefit from a 10% discount on the Article Processing Charges (APC) for any paper published in an MDPI journal, while the institution incurs no fee for participating in the program.

Simplification

There is no complex contract or hidden terms and conditions. The institution can cancel its participation in the program at any time. To support the simplification of payment processes, we can also adjust our invoicing procedure to meet the needs of each institution.

Transparency and Control

All institutional participants receive free access to our online submission system, which provides a wide range of metadata on articles under processing and articles published by associated authors since 2010.






Cost Reduction

Associated authors receive discounts on the APC for accepted articles and on the Book Processing Charges (BPC) for MDPI Books. In addition, the reduced admin efforts from our invoicing and access account process can help institutions to save time and effort.

The program is free and will remain free for as long as you continue participating. You may withdraw from the program at any time.
-  **10% discount on the APC**
Authors affiliated with the institution will receive a 10% discount on the APC for all papers published in an MDPI journal.
-  **Auto-archiving into your institutional repository**
We offer automated deposits of papers from affiliated authors to your institutional repository as long as it supports software SWORD 1.3.
-  **Access to the MDPI submission system**
The institution is granted free access to the MDPI online submission system and can receive free alerts of new submissions to our journals.
-  **Billing options of Non-central or Central**
By default, authors from the institution will continue to be invoiced directly (non-central billing) unless the institution opts for central billing.
